

Overview of Evidence Based Practice for ASD

This e-course was designed to introduce or review the evidence based practice process as it applies to supporting people with Autism. There will be an emphasis on behavioral and educational interventions. On completion, participants will be able to list 2 or more sources for information about evidence based intervention with persons on the autism spectrum, be able to list at least 4 examples of specific evidence based practices, and identify steps for planning and implementing evidence based practices effectively.
