



Quick Program Contact Guide

The following guide is provided to assist those looking for information about programs administered by the Developmental Disabilities Supports Division, including: The Developmental Disabilities (DD) Waiver, the Mi Via Waiver, the Medically Fragile Waiver, the Family Infant and Toddler (FIT) Program, and State General Fund Services.

- **The Developmental Disabilities Waiver (DD Waiver)** serves individuals with intellectual developmental disabilities and/or specific related conditions that occur before the age of 22. This program is designed to provide services and supports that will allow eligible individuals with developmental disabilities to participate as active members of their communities.

- **The Medically Fragile Waiver (MF Waiver)** serves individuals who have been diagnosed with a medically fragile condition before reaching age 22, and, who have a developmental disability or delay or who are at risk for developmental delay.

- **The Mi Via Waiver, is the State of New Mexico's self-directed waiver program.** The goal of Mi Via is to provide a community-based alternative that facilitates greater participant choice and control over the types of services and supports they receive.

- **The Family Infant Toddler (FIT) Program:** The FIT Program is a statewide program that provides early intervention services to infants, toddlers who have or are at risk for developmental delays and families in New Mexico. Early intervention provides activities and strategies for families to use to promote their child's development throughout the day.

- **State General Fund Services:** DDS provides an array of services and supports for individuals with developmental disabilities across the lifespan, including infants, toddlers, children and adults.
