ADOS-2 Introductory Clinical Workshop

The ADOS-2 is used for assessing and diagnosing Autism Spectrum Disorders across ages, developmental levels, and language skills. The second edition includes revised algorithms, a new comparison score for Modules 1-3, updated protocols with clearer administration and coding guidelines. The ADOS-2 introductory/clinical training workshop will use a lecture format and live demonstrations to introduce the basic principles of administering and scoring ADOS-2 modules 1 through 4 and provide an essential step toward competence in using the ADOS-2 in everyday clinical practice or for research purposes. This training does not include the Toddler Module Clinical Workshop.

Learning Objectives: Following the course, participants will be able to

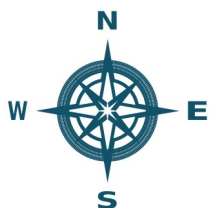
- Identify the key features of the ADOS-2 approach, including the rationale for the approach and how it enhances Autism Spectrum Disorder assessment

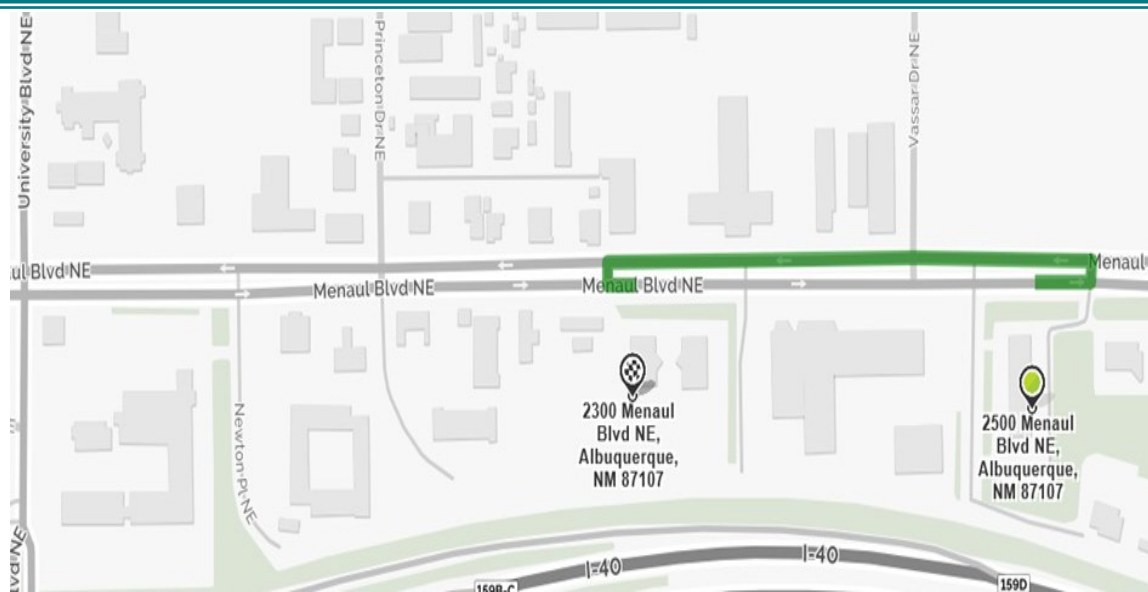
